What is NICRO?

NICRO is a South African non-profit organisation established in 1910. NICRO works in the crime and violence prevention sector, specialising in adults and children who present with high-risk behaviour and/or are in conflict with the law. NICRO reaches approximately 11 000 people per annum.

Where is NICRO Based?

NICRO's Head Office is in Cape Town, and has offices in Eastern Cape, Free State, Gauteng, KwaZulu-Natal, Limpopo, Mpumalanga, North West and Western Cape.

What Does NICRO Do?

NICRO provides a range of services for different audiences, including individual counselling, family counselling, psychoeducational programmes, educational workshops, community engagement and outreach, as well as professional skills development training.

Who Does NICRO Work With?

NICRO works with schools, businesses, government departments, communities, and private individuals.



What Services Does NICRO Provide:

- Assessments for diversion and non-custodial sentencing purposes
- Psychosocial assessments
- Individual counselling
- Family counselling
- Lifeskills programmes for adults and children
- Anger management programmes for youth and adults
- Substance abuse prevention programmes for adults and children
- Domestic violence programmes for perpetrators of domestic violence
- Parenting skills
- Road safety programmes
- Positive masculinities programmes for adults and children
- Economic empowerment programme
- Resilience development programme
- School violence prevention aligned with the National School Safety Framework
- Educational workshops in communities, schools and places of employment
- Employee wellness services.
