To lead the way to ending crime and building safe communities.

What is NICRO?

NICRO is a South African non-profit organisation established in 1910. NICRO works in the crime and violence prevention sector, specialising in adults and children who present with high-risk behaviour and/or are in conflict with the law. NICRO reaches approximately 11 000 people per annum.

Where is NICRO Based?

NICRO's Head Office is in Cape Town, and has offices in Eastern Cape, Free State, Gauteng, KwaZulu-Natal, Limpopo, Mpumalanga, North West and Western Cape.

What Does NICRO Do?

NICRO provides a range of services for different audiences, including individual counselling, family counselling, psychoeducational programmes, educational workshops, community engagement and outreach, as well as professional skills development training.

Who Does NICRO Work With?

NICRO works with schools, businesses, government departments, communities, and private individuals.



What Programmes Does NICRO Provide to Schools:

- **AUDIT:** high-risk drinking prevention programme for grades 8 - 12 (9 sessions).
- **Brighten my World:** a lifeskills programme that covers substance abuse, gangs, and bullying (10 sessions).
- **Anger Management:** (10 sessions).
- **Chance to Change (schools version):** an educational programme about alcohol and substance use (7 sessions).
- **Choosing the High Road:** a road safety programme (3 sessions).
- **Positive Masculinities:** a programmes for primary and high school (5 sessions).
- **Lionheart:** a positive masculinities programme aimed at older children, youth and men (14 sessions).
- **Safety Ambassadors:** a school-wide leadership development and safer school programme (12 months).



What Services Does NICRO Provide to Schools:

- **School Capacitation:**

- Child protection (safeguarding) training.
- School violence prevention training and capacitation aligned with the **National School Safety Framework**.
- Bullying prevention training for educators.
- Positive discipline and classroom management training.
- Employee wellness services such as stress management.
- NICRO can also develop custom training on topics related to crime and violence prevention.

- **Parents:**

- Parenting programme (8 sessions).
- Fatherhood programme (7 sessions).

- **School Community:**

- Educational workshops on crime and violence related topics.

- **Individual services:**

- Psychosocial assessments of learners.
- Individual counselling.
- Group counselling.
- Family counselling.
